Customizing the cave included connecting its controller to Comstock's in-home Control4 system. Doing so gives Comstock the option of controlling every aspect of the cave from any TV in his home or web browser. Now, if the system is left on and no one is in the cave, Comstock can turn off the entire cave without leaving the house. For safety, Comstock installed a camera to monitor activity and audio in the cave, allowing adults to supervise from a distance without intruding on playtime. The system also allows Comstock to send message via the TV telling the kids it's time to come back to the house.
