In addition, the hotel staff can set a maximum lighting threshold for guest rooms, dramatically reducing energy consumption without guests even noticing. Guests can also enjoy automated lighting during their stay. Even lamps and other plug-in devices in the room can be automated and controlled from the comfort of the guest's bed using the handheld remote.

Another way guests can make their stay more environmentally friendly is through the Green feature on the remote's keypad. This allows them to turn-off linen and towel service, create personalized Lighting Scenes, or choose the hotel's preferred Green setting. In addition, a master suite on/off switch near the guest room door allows guests or housekeeping to quickly push a button to automatically turn off all lights when they leave the room.
